Committee Chairman Tom Thomas called to order the Village of Eagle Police Committee Meeting at 7:03 p.m. Tom Thomas, Beverly Spurrell, Roger Couch, Chief Russell Ehlers and Officer Terri Duffy were in attendance.

Beverly Spurrell moved to approve the November 2008 Village of Eagle Police Committee meeting minutes, Roger Couch seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Public Comments – Tom Thomas received a concern from a citizen regarding snowmobiles on sidewalks. Chief stated he will put a note in the roll call book for the Officers to do extra patrols on this issue.

Accounts payable – None

Discussion of Cast Listing/Offense by reporting code and Tour of Duty. Chief stated that the police department had an increase of calls for service by 700 calls from 2007 to 2008.

Discussion of Police Department Hours – Chief stated that the police department office hours will be open during the hours of 8:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. unless our department received a call for service.

New Police Department Update – Chief stated that many citizens have made positive comments about the new police department. More visible signs will be posted outside of the police department. Chief explained to the committee that some officers came in and worked several hours to complete the move in a timely manner.

Discussion of conditions of return related to duty injured officers.

Discussion of possible future hiring process.

Discussion of DARE 2009 classes for Eagle Elementary and Palmyra Elementary. Officer James Bushey for Town of Linn will be our DARE officer for the 2009 school year.

Discussion of municipal citations bond increase – 936 municipal citations went to court in the 2008 year. Chief would like to further discuss an increase of the bond schedule for municipal citations.

The 1999 Crown Vic (Old unmarked squad) did not sell when it was parked in the Municipal lot by Shorewest with a “For Sale” sign on it. Chief Ehlers stated he has called Auction Associated and they will be picking the vehicle up to sell it through the Auction.

Motion for adjournment by Roger Couch seconded by Beverly Spurrell. All were in favor.
