Couch made a motion to approve the July Police Committee minutes. Scheff seconded the motion to approve the minutes. All were in favor.

Accounts payable - Chief Ehlers requested approval to purchase a new laser printer to replace the old one that no longer operates correctly. Couch motioned to approve the purchase of a new laser printer. Scheff seconded the motion.

Officer Bruckner will not be attending REID School because of the cost. Chief Ehlers stated the police department will be looking into cost for the training next year. Officer Brehmer will be attending Instructor Development School in November at WCTC in Pewaukee.
