RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, at a special meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Eagle, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, held on August 29, 1952, the Village Board of said Village was authorized and empowered to borrow the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), from the State Bank of Genesee Depot for temporary use which sums shall be repaid on October 29th, 19 52, pursuant to the provisions of Section 67.12 (12) Wisconsin Statutes as amended, together with interest at the rate of 4% per annum.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of said Village as governing body of said Village, borrow the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) from the State Bank of Genesee Depot, Genesee Depot, Wisconsin upon a note to be signed by the Officers of said Village; said note to be made, executed and delivered in accordance with section 67.12 (12), Wisconsin Statutes as amended; such loan to be for the term of sixty days, payable on Oct. 29th, 19 52, with interest at 4% per annum, payable at maturity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said note shall be paid from the funds of the special assessment bond issue to be issued.

The undersigned, being the duly elected and acting Officers of the Village of Eagle, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, does hereby certify that the above is a true and correct copy of a resolution which was duly adopted at a meeting of the Village Board of said Village held on August 29, 1952, at which meeting all members of the Board were present, and all members voted in favor of the adoption of the resolution.

A special meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Eagle, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, was held on the 29th day of October, 1952, at 7:30 o'clock P.M., all members being present.

The following resolution was then offered, seconded, and unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, special assessments have been levied to defray a part of the cost of constructing a waterworks plant in the Village of Eagle, Wisconsin, which assessments are payable in ten installments;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that to anticipate the collection of the unpaid special assessments there be issued Special Assessment B Bonds in an amount equal to the aggregate unpaid special assessments. Said bonds shall be dated as of November 1, 1952, and shall be in substantially the form given below.

The coupons on said bonds may be signed by the facsimile signatures of the Village President and Village Clerk, who shall thereby adopt such facsimile signatures as and for their own proper signatures.

Said bonds shall be sold to the Bank of Eagle, Eagle, Wisconsin at par and accrued interest and shall be registered in its name on the records of the Village Clerk.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT B BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Village of Eagle, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, for value received, promises to pay to the registered owner hereof, but solely from a fund created by collection of the installments of the special assessments hereinbelow described and the interest thereon, the principal amount of this bond, with interest at the rate of two and three quarters ($2\frac{3}{4}\%$) per annum from date hereof, as set forth in the coupons attached hereto. There shall be no obligation on the part of the Bank of Eagle to determine the right of the person presenting this bond or any coupon to accept and receive payments of either principal or interest for the registered owner.

No official of the Village of Eagle shall in any event be liable for any of the principal or interest of this bond, nor shall the Village of Eagle be liable for any of the principal or interest of this bond except from the fund created by the collection of the installments of said special assessments, together with the interest thereon.

This bond is issued pursuant to Section 66.54 (10) of the Wisconsin Statutes to anticipate the collection of special assessments levied by the Village Board to defray a part of the cost of constructing a waterworks plant in said Village, and is payable out of an assessment on the following described property.
