WHEREAS State Statute 61.65 requires Villages with Police Departments to establish either a Police Commission, the office of Police Commissioner or a Police Discipline Committee.

And

WHEREAS the Village of Eagle does not have a Police Commission, or a Police Commissioner, or a Police Discipline Committee,

And


WHEREAS the Village of Eagle has periodic matters to be handled by either a Police Commission, a Police Commissioner, or a Police Discipline Committee

THEREFORE be it resolved that the Village of Eagle establishes a Police Discipline Committee.


The Police Discipline Committee shall consist of three members with one, two and 3 year terms respectively and with the member initially having the three year term being the chairperson. Members shall be nominated by the Village Board President from a list of interested residents not then holding any other village elected or appointed office. Nominees will be approved by the full Board of Trustees. Members shall be compensated at the same rate as are the members of the Planning Commission.

The Police Discipline Committee will exist for the purpose of reviewing appeals of any disciplinary measures imposed against Police Officers by the Officer in Charge of the department or the Village Board according to state statute 62.13.
