Resolution 2005 - 02

WHEREAS State Statues allow Villages to restrict the keeping of dangerous animals within municipal boundaries,

And

WHEREAS incidents of a dangerous or potentially dangerous nature involving here to fore unrestricted animals within the Village of Eagle have taken place,

And

WHEREAS numerous Wisconsin municipalities have specific restriction ordinances for the protection of members of public, employees, and emergency service personnel,

And


WHEREAS the Village of Eagle lacks restrictions against the keeping of certain types of dangerous animals,


THEREFORE be it resolved that the Eagle Village Board of Trustees does hereby ordain that,

1. It shall be illegal for any person to keep, maintain or possess poisonous members of the animal kingdom for which a specialized antitoxin/antivenom is needed to treat the poisonous effects; and
2. It shall be illegal for any person to keep, maintain or possess reptiles capable of causing severe physical harm to human beings or domestic animals.

The penalty for infractions of this ordinance shall be the same in procedure and consequence as those already found in Village of Eagle Code Chapter 16 under abatement of public nuisances.
