A RESOLUTION TO CERTIFY THAT THE VILLAGE SHALL PROVIDE
FOR AND ALLOW THE LIBRARY TO EXPEND NO LESS THAN
THE COUNTY RATE IN THE PRIOR YEAR

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes Section 43.64 provides that certain municipalities may be exempt from the county library tax levy, and;

WHEREAS, the Village of Eagle and Town of Eagle jointly operate a municipal library.


WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Village of Eagle, by this Resolution, to provide written notice to the Waukesha County Board that the Village of Eagle shall appropriate and allow the Eagle Community Library (Alice Baker) to spend a sum at least equal to the amount set forth in WI Stat. 43.64(2)(b)1. & 2.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Village Board hereby certifies that it shall authorize as an appropriation to the Eagle Community Library (Alice Baker), for the year 2006, an amount at least equal to the amount as set forth in WI Stat 43.64(2)(b)1.&2.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Village of Eagle shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Waukesha County Board..


