RESOLUTION 2007-04

A RESOLUTION TO ORDER THE LAYING OF SIDEWALKS

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Stats. Section 66.0907(3) provides that a Village Board may by resolution determine where sidewalks shall be constructed and order that any sidewalk which is unsafe, defective or insufficient to be repaired or removed and replaced; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wisconsin Stats. Section 66.0907 a Village may require a property owner to install a sidewalk and Wisconsin Stats. Section 66.0907(3) provides that a copy of the resolution directing the laying, removal, replacement or repair of sidewalks shall be served upon the owner, or an agent, of each lot or parcel of land in front of which the work is ordered and that service of the notice may be made by certified or registered mail; and

WHEREAS, Village Board members have personally reviewed the condition of or lack thereof of sidewalks in certain areas of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Eagle hereby determines that it is in the public's interest to provide for pedestrian safety and convenience by requiring the installation and/or repair of sidewalks in certain locations; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety and convenience, the following locations are in need of having sidewalks installed and/or repaired;

- 1) On the north side of Waukesha Road, adjacent to 108 W. Waukesha Road and known as Eagle tax key # 1814-012-001
- 2) On the east side of Markham Road, south of the Eagle post office and the property known as Eagle tax key # 1819 998 005; and


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Village Board of the Village of Eagle;

- 1) That sidewalks are to be constructed on Markham Road on the property known as tax key #'s EGLV 1819 998 005 and in the location as depicted in the attached Exhibit A and on Waukesha Road on the property known as tax key #'s EGLV 1814 012 001 and in the location as depicted in the attached Exhibit B.
- 2) The owner of each lot or parcel abutting on that portion of the proposed sidewalks described in paragraph (1) of this Resolution shall cause the sidewalk to be constructed in front of his/her/its premises within 20 days of service of a copy of this Resolution.
- 3) If the owner fails to comply within the time specified, the Village Board shall cause the sidewalk construction to be done at the


expense of the owner by contract as permitted by Wisconsin Statutes.

- 4) The Village Clerk shall serve a copy of this Resolution and the attached Notice to each owner of property referred to above by mailing a copy of this Resolution by certified or registered mail.
