ORDINANCE NO. 36

ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF EAGLE, WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN, LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE PAYMENT OF PART OF THE COSTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER WORKS SYSTEM.

WHEREAS the Village Board of the Village of Eagle, has heretofore by ordinance duly adopted and published, dated the 25th day of June, 1952, declared its intention to levy a special assessment for the payment of part of the cost of the construction of a water works system against the property benefited thereby; and,

WHEREAS pursuant to said ordinance an award of benefits and damages has been made and filed with the village clerk of said village, wherein all property benefited and all property damaged has been set forth by name of the owner and a description of the lot and parcel so owned, and,

WHEREAS after due publication and notice posted a public hearing was held in the village hall on the 24th day of July, 1952, whereby all persons interested, their agents or attorneys, could be heard concerning the proposed assessments and awards of damages; and no one appearing to oppose or object to the same;

Now therefore be it ordained by the Village Board of the Village of Eagle, Waukesha County, Wisconsin as follows:

1. That the award of benefits and damages as heretofore made and set forth in the Special Assessment Book of said Village be and the same are duly adopted, and that the property benefited by the construction of the water works system be charged with the payment of said benefits to cover part payment of the costs, and that said benefits are hereby made a special assessment against the property benefited.
2. That the said assessment may be paid in ten equal annual installments and that the installments shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent. The first of such installments shall be placed on the 1953 tax roll and be paid and collected as all other taxes.
3. That all subsequent installments be placed on the tax rolls for the year that they become due and that the same be paid and collected as all other real estate taxes.
4. That said assessment shall be a lien on the real estate and remain thereon until paid.
5. That the option is given to pay the same in one payment on or before December 1, 1952.
6. That notice of the levy of this special assessment shall be given by the clerk by publication of an Installment Assessment notice by publication in the Eagle Quill, and by posting in three public places in said Village.
