

RESOLUTION NUMBER NINETY-TWO

WHEREAS the Conservation Division of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (formerly known as Conservation Commission) has been condemning and purchasing under threat of condemnation excessive amounts of land for park and recreation and forestry purposes, and

WHEREAS, as an example, approximately 8,000 acres of land has been so taken in the Townships of Eagle and Ottawa in Waukesha County, and the conservation authorities have publicly stated their intention of taking substantial additional acreage in these townships,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED ^{by Waukesha Co Board of Supervisors} that this convention of the Wisconsin County Board Association urge the passage of legislation prohibiting condemnation by the Conservation Division for such purposes without prior approval of the County Board in which such land is located.
