

VILLAGE OF EAGLE SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
“APPROVED” MINUTES – JUNE 14, 2010

President Spurrell called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The Clerk confirmed Open Meeting Law requirements. Roll was taken: Royston, Rice, Couch, Scheff, Greenberg, Block, Spurrell – all present.

Chief Ehlers read a letter he received back following the background check that was done on Daniel Oswald, who he would like the Village Board hire/appoint as a part-time police officer. Oswald is currently working part-time for Lannon, Big Bend, and Town of Summit police departments, and has one other part-time job. He received his Criminal Justice degree from WCTC in 2006, and has completed TASER training and is a practicing certified EMT.

Discussion followed regarding Oswald’s availability noting his other part-time positions. Chief Ehlers indicated that Oswald will try to make this position, if approved by the Board, a priority over the other ones. Upon question, Ehlers stated that the additional officer is needed due to the resignations of two (2) officers. Discussion followed regarding the number of officers, and whether there is an actual need for an additional officer. On the financial side, the hiring would not affect the police budget. Block made a motion to approve the hiring of Daniel Oswald as a Village of Eagle part-time police officer. Greenberg seconded. Under further discussion, and for the record, President Spurrell clarified that Oswald would be replacing one (1) officer. All in favor; motion carries.

Motion by Greenberg to adjourn; Royston seconded. All in favor; motion carries.
